Our school initiatives are showing substantial progress toward our targets

After reviewing our 2018 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Collection of student performance data on reading to inform classroom planning, teaching and support plans
- Implementation of a consistent three day a week reading block in each classroom
- Employed a skilled Speech Therapist to coordinate the whole school phonemic awareness program and build capacity of P-6 teachers in delivering targeted oral language program
- Released teachers to work with specialist and admin staff to discuss and analyse student data in reading and focused on improving pedagogy
- Supported a Lead teacher in SSP/STRIVE to model/coach/support classroom teachers in ensuring consistency of practice throughout the school
- Provided teacher and teacher aide support to pre-prep ages students to support and guide their literacy and numeracy skills prior to them commencing school
- Employed a teacher to ensure class sizes remain small in numbers
- Engaged leadership team and staff with Lyn Sharrat and Regional Project Officer to target explicit teaching of students in reading, to increase the number of students meeting regional/national benchmarks
